#### Wayne County Meal On Wheels Program Available - No Income Criteria

#### **Eligibility Guidelines**

Persons age 60 and over who are incapacitated due to accident, illness or frailty; lack of support of family, friends, or neighbors; and are unable to prepare meals because of lack of facilities such as refrigeration, stove, etc., inability to shop and cook for self, inability to safely prepare meals, or lack of knowledge and skills to prepare meals.

Our staff completes an assessment to determine eligibility and to see if there are any other needs our office might be able to help with. The menus are prepared by a registered dietician and meet strict nutritional guidelines to be as close to 1/3 RDA as possible for all nutrients, calories, etc. We publish our menus in our newsletter, and (try to remember to) put them on our county website and Facebook.

There are <u>no income criteria</u> or restrictions for program eligibility, but we do send out monthly contribution letters to allow people who wish to contribute toward the cost of their meals to do so.

# Ontario Chamber of Commerce Business of the Month August, 2020 COBBLESTONE HOP YARD 5736 Walworth Road Ontario, NY

Cobblestone Hop Yard is the Business of the Month for August, 2020 named by the Ontario Chamber of Commerce, Inc. Started by owner Cheryl Bebernitz Wygal in 2015, the business occupies 8 acres east side of Walworth Road, across from Paddy Lane. The hops' yard produces some 7,000 pounds of hops on the same land where Cheryl's grandfather, Arno Bebernitz,, raised corn, wheat and oats for over 60 years. She noted that the "Cobblestone" name is in honor of her grandfather's cobblestone home, which is now the home of her father and step-mother on the south edge of the family farm.

Her goal is to produce 1,000 pounds of hops per acre from the multiple rows of 20 foot plants. The cone-shaped flowers of the hops plant have more than a dozen varieties that create the bitterness and aroma in beer products. Cobblestone Hop Yard has about two dozen customers from mostly New York breweries. Each year, they host a "hops' fest" to showcase their business to the public and to celebrate the brewers who are their customers.
