### ONTARIO CHAMBER TOURS COBBLESTONE HOP YARD 5736 WALWORTH ROAD ONTARIO, NEW YORK 14519

**ONTARIO - July 20, 2021.** Ontario chamber members gathered to learn about the growing and harvesting of hops. Cheryl Wygal, owner of Cobblestone Hop Yard, hosted our tour.

Cheryl reviewed her background and informed us after raising five children she wanted to find a profession that would incorporate her degree in horticulture. Just like raising kids, raising hops also provided challenges and can be a bit "tricky". After studying everything she could about hops for a couple years: how they grow, diseases, insects, soil types, varieties, she started her business on what was her Grandpa Bebernitz's farm at 5736 Walworth Road, Ontario, NY.

Hops are a very labor-intensive crop. In the spring, Cheryl ties 15,000 coir strings to the cables which are 18' above the plants; mostly by her own hand; after which, two to three bines are trained to grow up the coir. Her son, Jonathan, helps her out in the busy Spring and Harvest seasons. In the summer, every ten days the hops are sprayed to protect them from Downy Mildew, and to prevent insect infestations as needed. The season runs from mid April to the middle of September. Cobblestone grows 14 different varieties of hops. They grow to a height of 18-20 feet.

Harvesting is a multistep process. Hops are cut 2-3 feet above ground level at the bottom and cut at the top, twine and all, and dropped neatly on a wagon and brought to the barn to be run through the Hops Harvester; which strips and sorts the leaves and cones from the main bine. Her crew of three or four can pick about one-third of an acre a day. Hops must be on the drier within an hour of picking to be dried to a moisture content of 8% or they get moldy. Once they are dried and processed into pellets, they are boxed in 11 lb. boxes and ready for delivery.

Cobblestone Hop Yard began in 2015 and had the first saleable crop in 2017. At  $7 \frac{1}{2}$  acres, with  $2 \frac{1}{2}$  more to plant, it is the largest woman owned and farmed hops yard in New York State. Most of her hops are distributed to breweries in New York State, mostly in the Finger Lakes region; but she even has customers as far away as North Carolina. She prefers to personally deliver the hops because she feels the personal connection is what using local ingredients is all about.

The Ontario Chamber of Commerce wishes to thank Cheryl Wygal for taking the time to provide a very interesting and informative tour of the hops industry.
