Treasurer's Report: Frank Robusto

- Balance = \$22,939.88 + Craft Account
- Some bills being paid online, easier to access and manage

Old Business:

- **Tree lighting** went off very well. Suggestion to move the parade down further. Christine will attend the bid meeting and will provide updates.
- **Jan 9th networking event** went well but the weather was a deterrent. Tour of the church was given, North Coast catering provided food. Suggested that we do our own Ontario networking event.
- **Chamber shirts:** discussed having a shirt with OCC embroidered on it. Donna will resend the link to purchase shirts and members can order their own. Bill will have them embroidered.
- **Donation to Wayne County Humane Society.** No response from Williamson or Sodus.
 - Suggested the \$250 paver as a way to donate and have our name be recognized.
 - No vote at this time to approve donation
- **Zoom meetings**: Discussion around adding Zoom to our monthly meetings. Would allow members to join and contribute when they couldn't physically be there.
 - o Can be discussed further with the creation of the Technology Committee
 - Expense of new equipment to broadcast

New Business:

- **Term of board of directors** (3 yr term) Bylaws are for 3 currently. Sylvia questioned if we should increase this number. We need more volunteers to help with events. We will start with working on committees to share and organize the work for events.
- Committees

- **Website** Continued discussion with Nicole from Williamson Chamber around building new website
- Masons looking for a contribution of \$75 for advertising on placemats. 3k patrons would see the placemat. Christine made a motion and Brian second. Consensus

- Potential new CRM is called Customer Factory (Christine and Brian reviewed at an event with the Williamson Chamber)
- Donna discussed a NYS Workers Compensation meeting informational event what's required by the state for businesses. She will follow up for more details (Zoom or in Person)
