

HOME OCCUPATIONS IN THE TOWN OF ONTARIO

Anyone interested in starting a home occupation business within the Town of Ontario should contact the Town of Ontario's Code Enforcement Officer, Brian Smith, 1850 Ridge Road, Ontario, NY 14519, (315) 524-7170, ext. 300 or email: codeofficer@ontariotown.org.

The town will require you to fill out a Home Occupation Form. The requirements to qualify for a home occupation are listed below:

HOME OCCUPATION

Any use customarily conducted entirely within a dwelling, provided that such use is carried on solely by the residents of the dwelling and is clearly incidental and secondary to the use of the dwelling for dwelling purposes, and meeting the performance standards set forth in **150-42B(15)** of this chapter.

150-42(B)

Home occupations shall comply with the following:

(a)

Such use shall be located in an owner-occupied dwelling unit and on the same lot. No more than 35% of such dwelling may be so used for above occupation.

(b)

Such use shall be conducted by persons living in the dwelling unit and not more than one additional person who does not live in such unit.

(c)

All activity, including storage, shall be conducted entirely within the dwelling unit or accessory building, and no special construction or structural alteration is required.

(d)

The use shall not display or create outside the building any evidence of the home occupation, except that one nonilluminated sign, not more than three square feet, may be posted.

(e)

No offensive traffic, noise, odor, smoke, dust, heat, glare or electrical disturbance shall be produced by the home occupation.
